- Exhibitors & Vendors

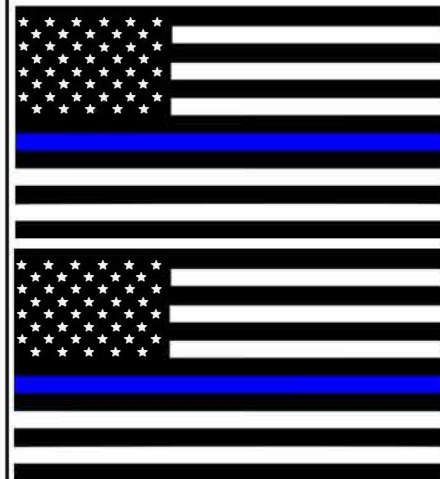
